

Tudhoe Moor Nursery School Policy for Transition to School.



Policy Statement

The staff and Governors of Tudhoe Moor Nursery School believe that it is their duty to prepare all children for main stream school and manage a smooth transition into their chosen school. We seek to highlight the liaison that we have with the many schools that our children transfer to.

We accept that careful handling of transition procedures is an important aspect of nursery work therefore, because each child has attended the nursery for a period of up to five terms and the staff feel that they can pass on valuable information to receiving staff.

All staff of Tudhoe Moor Nursery acknowledge that children regardless of their individual ability are entitled to as smooth a transition into mainstream school as it is possible to provide.

Procedures

It is the aim of staff and Governors of Tudhoe Moor Nursery School acknowledge that in order to provide a smooth transition from nursery to main stream school they will :-

1. Arrange with feeder schools for the children to have a number of visits.
2. Arrange for reception staff to visit the nursery and see the children in the nursery environment.
3. Arrange for records to be passed over to feeder schools and also to pass on any other relevant information.
4. To use outreach workers to support children and families through the transition of SEN children to 'special' school.

Tudhoe Moor Nursery School staff and Governors provide a smooth transition to mainstream school for all pupils who are of statutory school age.
