Policy statement for emergency medical care



Policy Statement

This policy is to inform you as a parent/carer what would happen if your child were to be involved in an emergency situation at our nursery, e.g. an accident that required hospital treatment urgently and you or care could not be contacted.

Staff will: -

- Call an ambulance
- Try informing the extra emergency contact people on the registration form
- Accompany the child to hospital (if parent/carer hasn't arrived to take them) take registration form and any relevant documentation to the hospital to assist with hospital administration
- Staff at the nursery will constantly try to contact any nominated adults from the registration form
- Follow doctors advice on any medical procedures (unless otherwise stated on registration form, e.g. religious beliefs)
- If still unable to contact parents/carers the member of staff will stay with the child and outside agencies will become involved, i.e. social care direct
